BLUE SPORT HONOUR

To be awarded a 'Blue Sports Badge', recipients show exceptional National Representation achievement in a sports code within the last 12 months and at a New Zealand age level while following and upholding our school values, and showing excellent attendance.

The Applicant must:

- Selected for a New Zealand, Aotearoa Age Group and taken part in the competition
- Umpiring/officiating at a national/international level
- Placed in the top 3 or 20% at a National Sanctioned competition in a sport while representing Te Paepae o Aotea eg. New Zealand Secondary Schools

BURNT ORANGE SPORT HONOUR

To be awarded an 'Orange Sports Badge', Year 11-13 recipients show exceptional regional achievement in a sports code within the last 12 months, as well as meeting the Sports Sliver Badge guidelines, while following and upholding our school values, and showing excellent attendance.

The applicant must be:

- Named in a Regional/NZ tournament team
- Umpiring/officiating at a regional level
- Compete in all competitions for your regional team
- Selected to attend a NZ training camp or training squad

SILVER SPORT HONOUR

To be awarded a 'Silver Sports Badge', students must have demonstrated a consistent and exceptional level of ability, dedication, and commitment to their chosen sporting activity. All Year 11-13 recipients will have had to represent Te Paepae o Aotea in the highest team or category for two years while following and upholding our school values, and having excellent attendance.

** Badge achievement exception can be taken into consideration for students who are Year10.

The Applicant must:

- Demonstrate excellence in their chosen team or individual sport, this includes umpiring/officiating for a school/local team
- Have shown outstanding commitment to the team/sport including games, practices, and service for the current year
